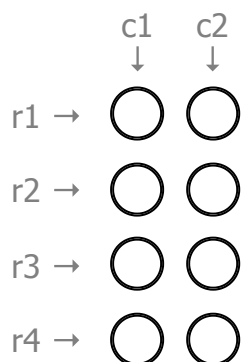

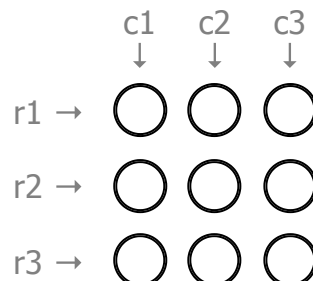
Below is an array with:

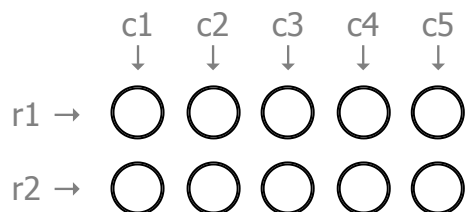
Below is an array with:

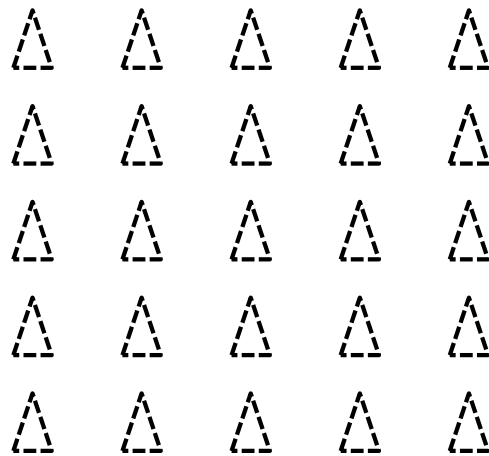
Problem of the Day Lesson 19

b. Show the trees Joe plants.

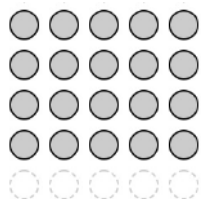

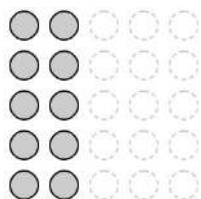

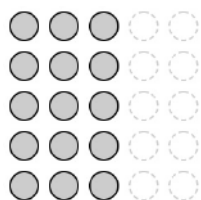

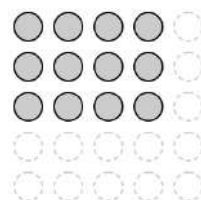
