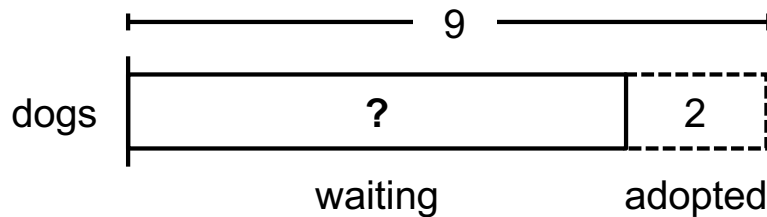

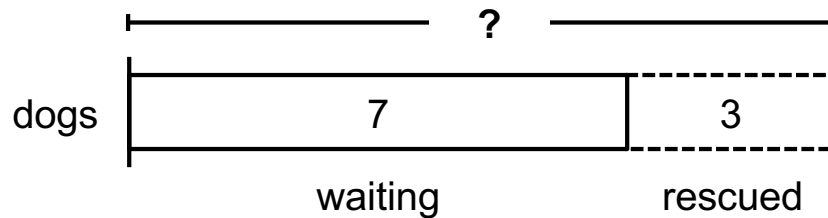
There are 9 dogs at the animal shelter. A lucky family adopts 2 dogs.
