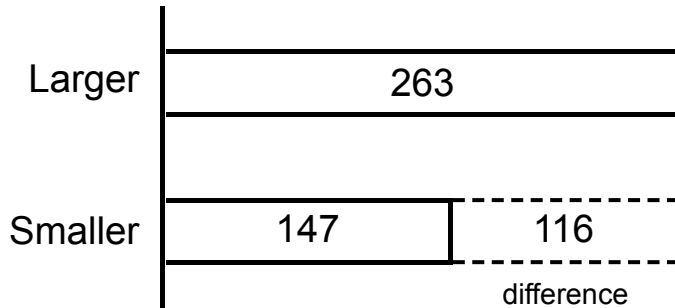


- A. The larger number is 263.

How much greater is 263 than 147?

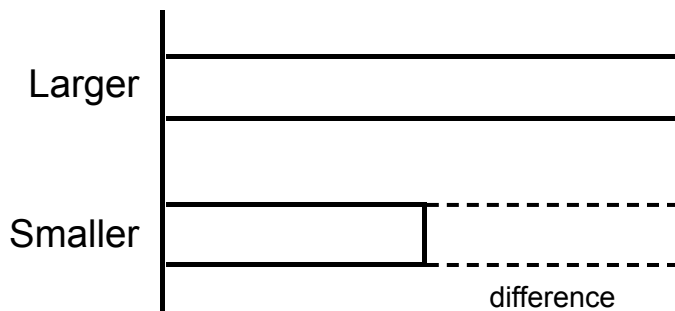


$$263 - 147 = \underline{\mathbf{116}}$$
