Problem of the Day Lesson 118

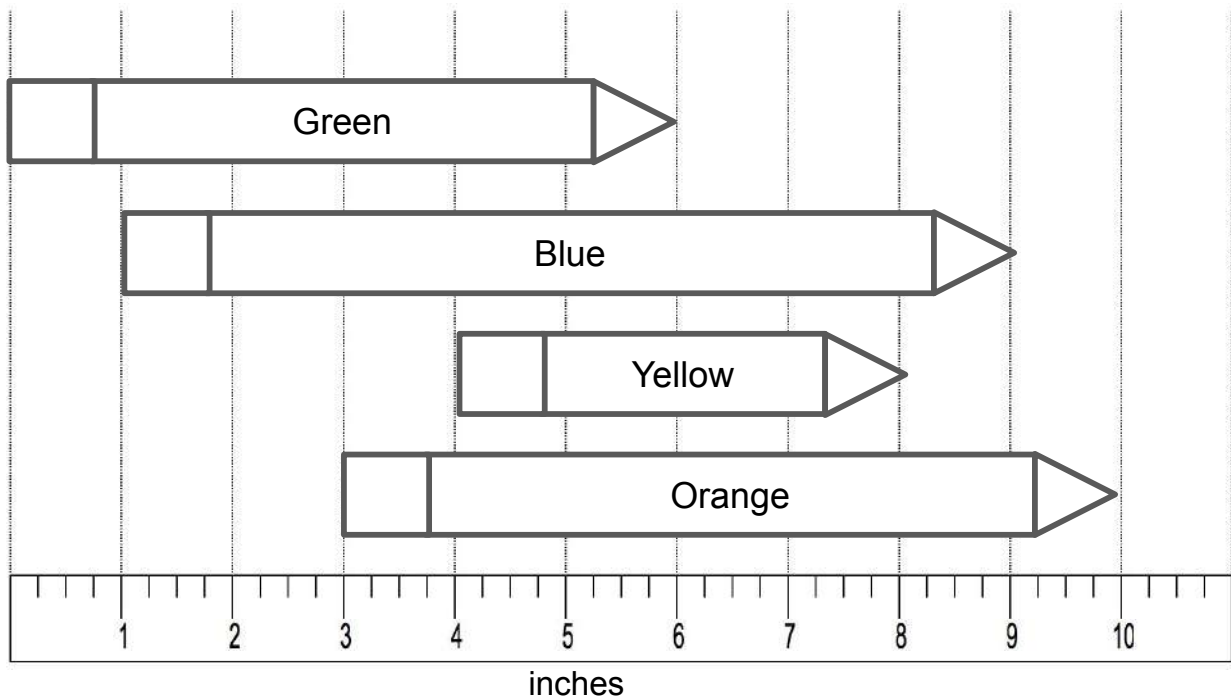
Mrs. Gaines is buying a new rug for her room. To help her figure out what size to buy, she asks 2 students, Chip and Joanna, to measure her room.
