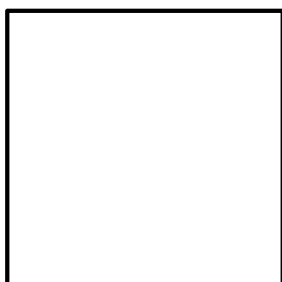


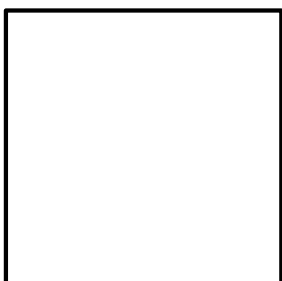
Use a clever “dot strategy” to divide a square into 2, 3, or 4 equal parts.

- a. Draw a dot in the middle. Draw a vertical line through the dot to make 2 equal parts.



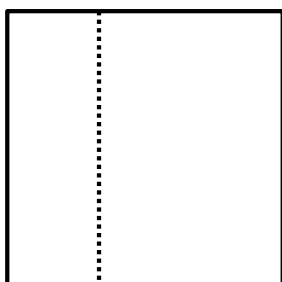
There are _____ halves
