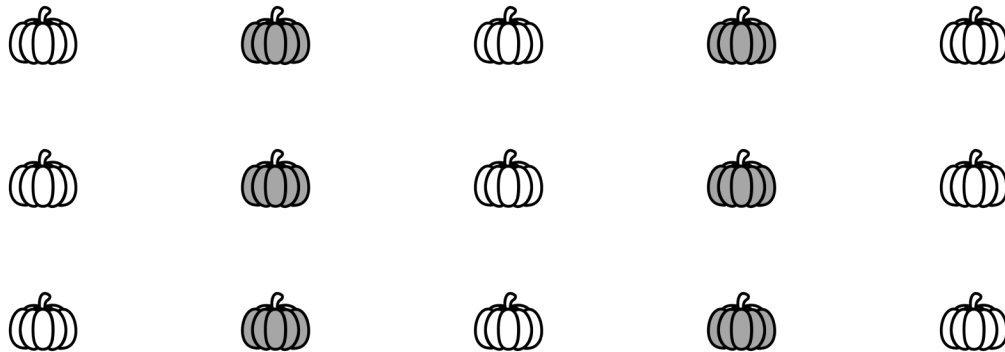


3 schools share the 15 pumpkins below.
