To make a picture frame, Joy starts with a wood stick that is 20 inches long.

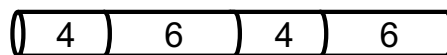


Joy cuts the stick into 4 equal pieces. Which picture shows Joy's stick now?

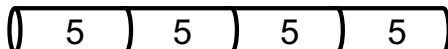

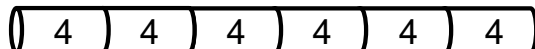
