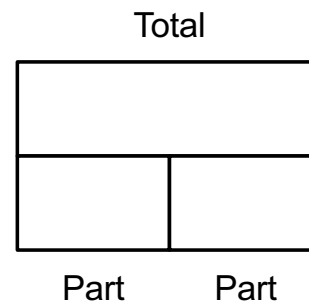


Peter picks some peppers. Mary gives him 25 more peppers.
