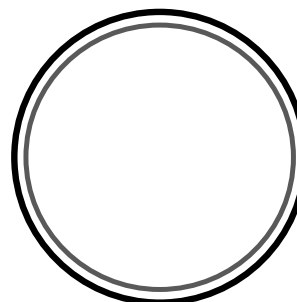


Pizza D and Pizza E are the same size.

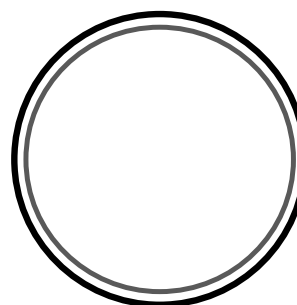
Pizza D
