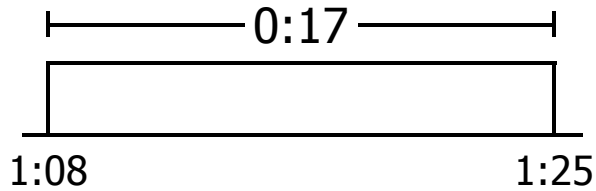

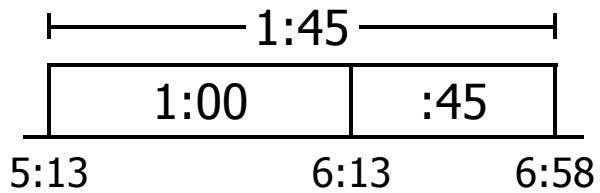

SPLIT DECISION

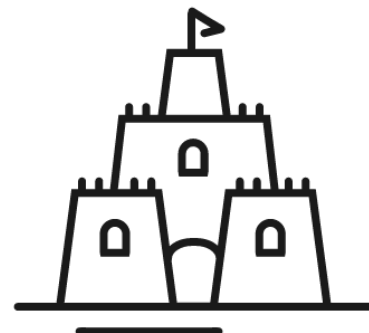
Read each scenario and then answer the related questions.
