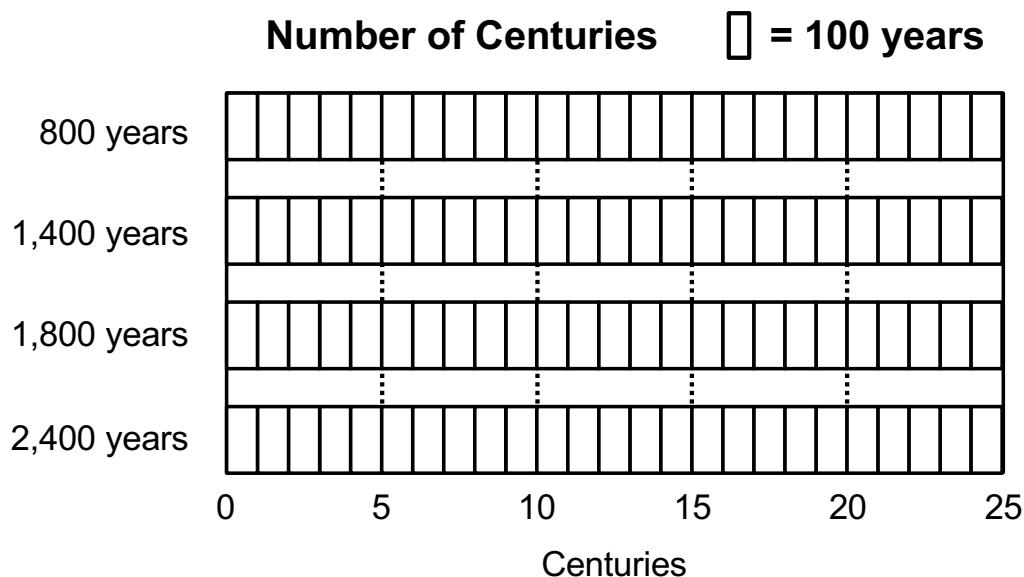


Color the scaled, horizontal bar graph to show the number of centuries.



Divide years by thinking in centuries.

$$\begin{aligned}
 800 \text{ yr} \div 4 &= \underline{\quad} \text{ centuries} \div 4 \\
 &= \underline{\quad} \text{ centuries} \\
 &= \underline{\quad} \text{ years}
 \end{aligned}$$

 1,400 \text{ yr} \div 2 &= \underline{\quad} \text{ centuries} \div 2 \\
