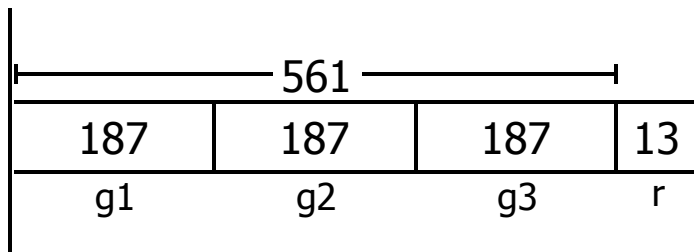


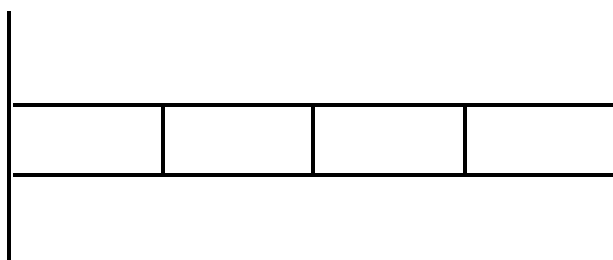

 \end{aligned}$$

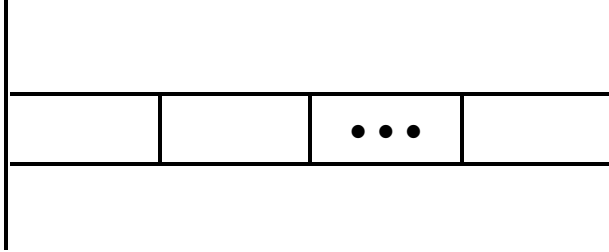

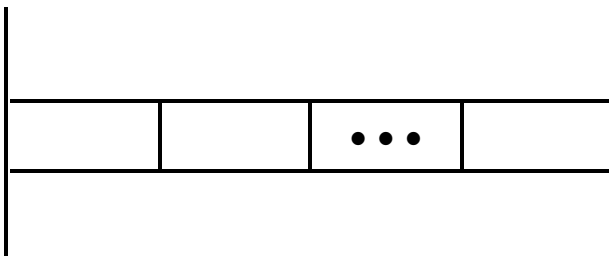

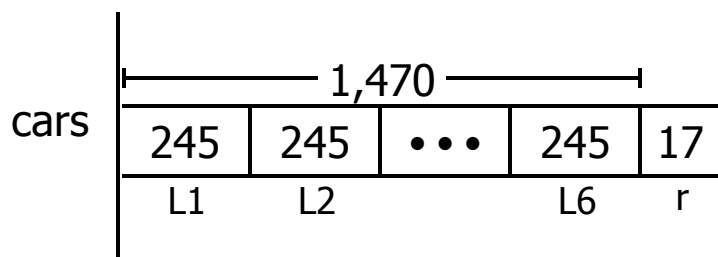

 6 \times 245 &= \underline{\mathbf{1,470}} \\
 1,470 + 17 &= \underline{\mathbf{1,487}} \\
 (6 \times 245) + 17 &= \underline{\mathbf{1,487}}
 \end{aligned}$$
