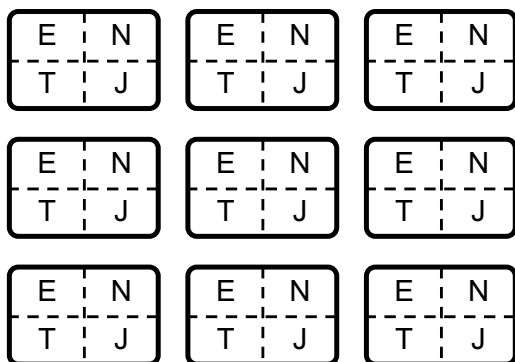


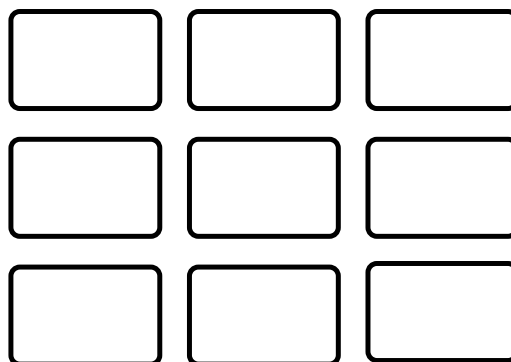

Ed's Strategy

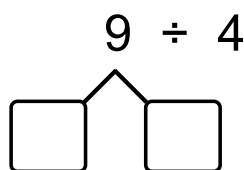


Ned's Strategy
